- Fall is in the air, which means pumpkin EVERYTHING! Pumpkin spice lattes, pumpkin bread, and pumpkin pie top the list of fall favorites! Here are a few fun pumpkin facts to get you in the spirit:
  - Pumpkin decorating originated when the Irish came to America. Prior to that, jack-o-lanterns were made from potatoes or turnips.
  - The largest pumpkin pie ever baked was in 2005 and weighed 2,020 pounds.
  - Pumpkins are indigenous to the Western Hemisphere and have been growing in North America for over 5,000 years!
  - Pumpkins are a nutrient-dense food that can be very healthy! They are low in calories, fat and sodium, while also being high in fiber. They are excellent sources of Vitamin A, Vitamin B, potassium, protein and iron!

- The heaviest pumpkin ever grown was a whopping 2,600 pound in 2016 and was grown in Germany.
- The word “pumpkin” showed up for the first time in the fairy tale Cinderella.

### **The Outlaw Josey Wales**

*Wednesday, October 7th:*

Josey Wales (Clint Eastwood) watches helplessly as his wife and child are murdered, by Union men led by Capt. Terrill (Bill McKinney). Seeking revenge, Wales joins the Confederate Army. He refuses to surrender when the war ends, but his fellow soldiers go to hand over their weapons -- and are massacred by Terrill. Wales guns down some of Terrill's men and flees to Texas, where he tries to make a new life for himself, but the bounty on his head endangers him and his new surrogate family.

### **Pride and Prejudice**

*Sunday, October 11th*

In this adaptation of Jane Austen's beloved novel, Elizabeth Bennet (Keira Knightley) lives with her mother, father and sisters in the English countryside. As the eldest, she faces mounting pressure from her parents to marry. When the outspoken Elizabeth is introduced to the handsome and upper-class Mr. Darcy (Matthew MacFadyen), sparks fly. Although there is obvious chemistry between the two, Darcy's overly reserved nature threatens the fledgling relationship.

### **Bertie and Elizabeth**

*Wednesday, October 14th*

The Story of King George and Queen Elizabeth- The story of Elizabeth, later the Queen Mother, and Bertie, Duke of York, from their marriage in 1923 to his death in 1952. Life changed for the family when the abdication crisis of 1936 put Bertie on the throne as George VI, and shortly after the coronation, the country was plunged into World War II.

### **Les Misérables**

*Sunday, October 18th*

After 19 years as a prisoner, Jean Valjean (Hugh Jackman) is freed by Javert (Russell Crowe), the officer in charge of the prison workforce. Valjean promptly breaks parole but later uses money from stolen silver to reinvent himself as a mayor and factory owner. Javert vows to bring Valjean back to prison.
