



## Maintenance

Regular business hours are Monday – Friday 7:00am-3:30pm. Maintenance is available on-call for emergent needs on weekends and after hours. Some examples of a maintenance emergency include: Air conditioning or heat not working, no hot water, water leaks or flooding, and egress related issues. Note: If your smoke detector is alarming and saying “fire” or “carbon monoxide”, please contact 911, do not contact the front desk.

Maintenance can assist with hanging personal items as time allows and will provide basic hardware. Any hardware beyond what we consider basic (shelves, nuts, bolts, hangers, TV mount, etc.) for personal use should be supplied by the tenant. Grab bars are supplied and installed free of charge.

### October 28th National First Responders Day

National First Responders Day commemorates the heroic acts of men and women who are there first on the scene of an emergency. Thank you to our firefighters, EMTs, paramedics, police officers and others who risk their lives to save others.

### October 31st Halloween

Halloween, also known as All Hallows' Eve or All Saints' Eve, is a popular celebration around the world loved by adults and children.

#### Fun facts about Halloween:

- Halloween is the second largest commercial holiday in the US, after Christmas. A quarter of all candy sales happen during this spooky season.
- The Jack o'lantern comes from the Irish legend about a man named Stingy Jack. People in Ireland and Scotland began creating Jack o'lanterns out of turnips, beets, and potatoes.

• According to Guinness World Records, the highest number of lit Jack o'lanterns on display is 30,581 by the City of Keene, New Hampshire in 2013.

• Candy Corn was originally known as Chicken Feed when it was created in 1880. Over 35 million pounds of Candy Corn are sold each year, with sales peaking on or around Halloween and National Candy Corn Day.

• Harry Houdini, the world-famous magician and illusionist, died on Halloween after his appendix burst in 1926.
